Jobs Victoria is the Victorian Government's \$619.4 million investment to help Victorians get back to work and businesses find the right workers. If you are a Victorian employer, we can offer a range of supports and services.

The <u>Jobs Victoria Fund</u> is providing \$250 million in wage subsidies to assist Victorian businesses to employ at least 10,000 people who are looking for work.

The Jobs Victoria Fund will support employers to grow and recover while helping Victorians looking for work into steady jobs. You may be eligible for a subsidy of up to \$20,000 to employ people who have been most affected by the economic impacts of the pandemic.

If you are hiring staff, you can register your business on our Jobs Victoria <u>online hub</u> to post jobs and connect with a growing pool of people ready to work for you. This free and easy-use service will offer you a shortlist of local candidates with the skills and experience you need – saving you time and money.

Our Jobs Victoria Advocates team provides face-to-face support to jobseekers in the community and connects them with employment services, skills and training. Jobs Victoria Mentors offer tailored services to jobseekers and engage with employers to link them with the staff they need. Kyriakos loved that the hub is free to use - "a big plus for small start-ups like us, in terms of managing costs" – and that it's government-run, so he could rest easy knowing their information was safe

"There's that element of trust from being within a platform that's run by the government, and then you have access to all these great applicants who really want to work."

Kyriakos set up Just Gold as an employer on the hub and posted the position descriptions. He found it to be a very simple and easy-to-use recruitment asset – and he picked up some interesting tricks along the way.


"I didn't know at first look that you can ask people to write a short answer to a question. This allowed us to get better candidates."

We support Victorian jobseekers and employers in their local communities through face-to-face services, online and over the phone.

Jobs Victoria Advocates meet with jobseekers in their local communities – in libraries, community centres, sports clubs, public housing foyers and shopping centres - to connect people with the information, support and training that's right for them.

Jobs Victoria Mentors help people to them, and support them in their role for the first six months. Jobs Victoria employers to identify their business needs, and Mentors connect employers to candidates with the right skills and potential to work in their business.






